

FINISHING TOUCHES – MAKING POM POMS!

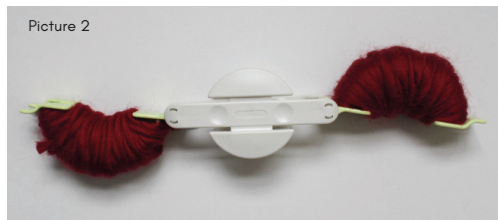


This is my preferred method of making pom poms. I recommend using the Clover Pom Pom maker, which is available via my website shop.

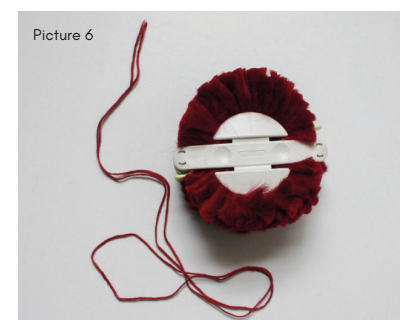
I also use Merino wool as I find they give the most amazing fluffy soft finish to your pom poms!



- Choose the size of pom pom you would like to make. (I used the green medium size and orange (2nd biggest) maker).
- Open up your pom pom maker (picture 1).
- Wrap your yarn around one open half, and then the other (picture 2).
- Close the 2 halves to form a circle (picture 3 and 4).



- Once you have closed the pom pom maker, take a sharp pair of scissors and cut the yarn around the circumference (picture 5).
- Take a piece of embroidery thread of the same colour and tie it around the circumference of the cut yarn tightly, knotting it in place (picture 6).



- Open out the pom pom maker (picture 7 and 8).
- Trim your pom pom to a good round shape and you are all done! (picture 9)
